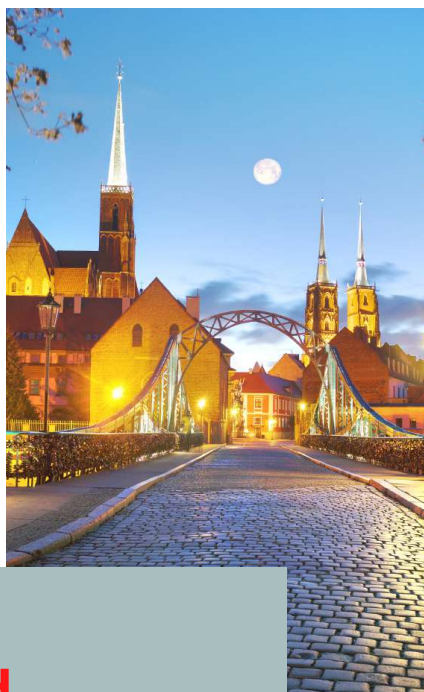

THE MARKET SQUARE OF WROCLAW - HEART OF THE CITY

One of the largest in Poland and Europe - the Market Square of Wrocław is currently the heart of the city, which is constantly teeming with life. The central point is focused on the eye-catching Gothic Town Hall with an impressive clock and 66-meter tall tower and Piwnica Świdnicka, which was one of the first gastronomic establishments in Europe.

During the sightseeing, you can observe many beautifully restored, colorful tenement houses that surround the central commercial square of the city. You can also admire The Market Square of Wrocław from the two viewpoints - one of them is located on the tower of the Church of St. Elizabeth and the other one on the Bridge of Penitents between the towers of the Church of St. Mary Magdalene.

OSTRÓW TUMSKI - THE CATHEDRAL ISLAND

The Cathedral Island - Ostrów Tumski means the beginning of the history of Wrocław. The favorable location on the island, with natural borders separated by the Odra River, were the perfect factors for pagan tribes to settle here in the past times. Although nowadays Ostrów Tumski is no longer an island, it still attracts crowds of tourists wanting to see the "Little Vatican" - numerous churches hidden in the narrow, charming streets with the impressive two-tower archcathedral of St. John the Baptist.

THE CENTENNIAL HALL - PIECE OF MODERNISM

The only one building in Wrocław, which is inscribed on the UNESCO's World Heritage List and located in a picturesque place on the territory of the Great Island. The characteristic shape and original construction make the building unique on an international scale.

It is also a place, which from the very beginning was intended for various events such as exhibitions and performances. The facility fulfills these functions until today. In addition, the areas in the surrounding of the Centennial Hall are adjusted to the recreation of inhabitants and encourage tourists to visit Wrocław.

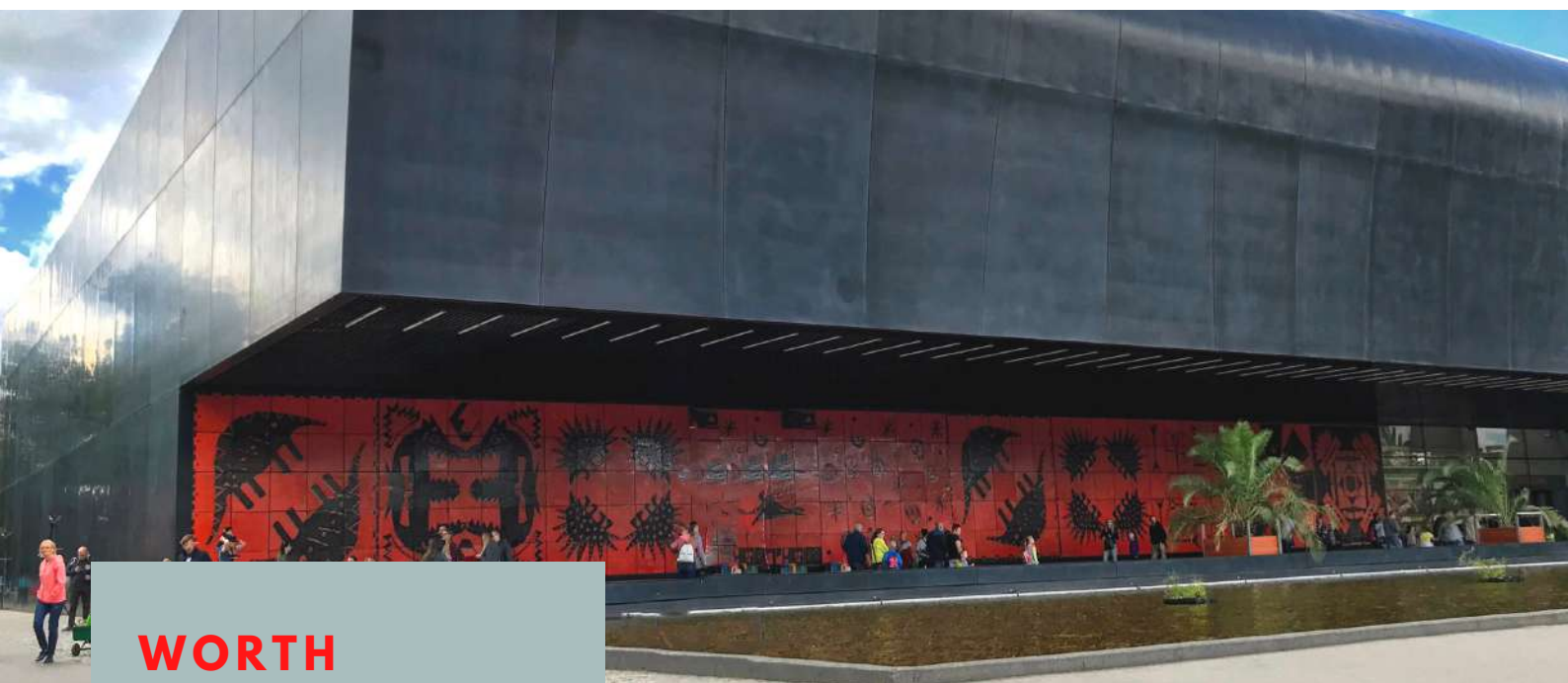

THE ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN & AFRICARIUM - WEALTH OF FAUNA AND FLORA

The oldest working Zoological Garden in Poland, which is open all year round and invites visitors to learn about more than 1000 species of animals - including exotic ones. The Zoo also has the Africarium presenting fauna and flora of the Dark Continent, which are unique on an international scale. The Wrocław Zoo is also one of the exhibition grounds, and together with The Centennial Hall they are included in a huge recreational and tourist area. The Wrocław Zoological Garden is one of the most preferably visited places on the tourist map of the city.

HYDROPOLIS - THE KNOWLEDGE CENTER ABOUT WATER

If you could describe Hydropolis in few words it would be the center of knowledge and information about water, which thanks to its form, is entertaining for viewers at any age. The interactive form of the display means, that the exhibition is not boring, and a large number of educational games helps to increase recognition of understanding how important water is for us. An interesting fact is the choice of place for this venue – as it is located in the former clean water tank from 1893. Each of the 9 thematic zones shows water from a different perspective - you have to see it with your own eyes.

THE COPERNICUS AIRPORT WROCLAW - INTERNATIONAL TRAVELING

Wrocław Airport has a convenient location for both, arriving from the center of Wrocław (about 10 km) and those traveling from beyond the agglomeration. The Airport is located near the Wrocław Motorway Bypass (AOW), which can be reached via expressways and highways such as A4 (from Katowice or Berlin), S8 (from Warszawa, from Łódź) or S5 (from Poznań). The air travellers can rent a car at international airport rental companies, get to the center by public transportation, using a shuttle bus (operates on the route Main Bus Station - Airport) or taxi services. From Wrocław you can easily reach couple of European capital cities, like Paris, Copenhagen, Amsterdam, London or Zurich.
